

What are our soaps made of?

The heart of our soap is tallow, sourced from animals raised on the green pastures and fresh sea air of the Sounds. We hand-render all the fat ourselves and use it in our soaps comprising at least 50%. Tallow naturally aligns with our skin's chemistry, making it incredibly gentle and nourishing.

We use micas (same as eye-shadow), natural colours, and phthalate-free fragrances to create a good smelling and beautiful soap. Other ingredients can be coconut-, castor-, olive- and other oils. Most of our soaps contain sugar and citric acid to create the special properties we want to achieve.

Herbs and flowers used in our infused blends are hand-gathered from our own garden in beautiful Picnic Bay in the Kenepuru Sound, adding a touch of local flora and colour.



Why buy handmade Soap?

Forget grandma's harsh laundry bars! Our soaps retain nourishing oils (usually about 8% superfat) for a skin-friendly experience, unlike the lye soaps of the past. (Actually – we do sell laundry sticks too, but they are strictly for laundry.)

Handmade soaps differ from their industrial counterparts in their retention of natural glycerin. Contrary to industrial soaps, where glycerin is often removed for other uses, ours remains within the bar - contributing to its mildness and through its ability to attract moisture from the air, leaving your skin feeling refreshed and pampered without dryness.

Each bar undergoes a dedicated four-week curing process, resulting in a soap with improved hardness, lather quality, and exceptional gentleness.

For people with extra sensitive skin we offer our "PURE" soaps which are fragrance free with natural colour. Or you might try our popular soaps with Pine Tar and Neem oil. Some of our tallow comes from organic farms (not certified) and we do make 100% tallow soap, some with infused herbs and essential oils.

Or put it in one of our soap saver bags and hang it in an airy spot.

Sustainable suds, anyone? Our soaps are longlasting, but even the tiniest sliver should not be wasted. That's where Heike's hand-crocheted soap saver bags come in! Crafted from ecofriendly milk cotton and washable at 30°C, these bags extend the life of your soap while also whipping up a luxurious lather.

Eco-friendly packaging

Our soaps are wrapped in plant-based cellulose bags (home-compostable) and secured with cellulose tape. The boxes are made from cardboard. Just compost the bag, recycle the box, and enjoy your soaps.
